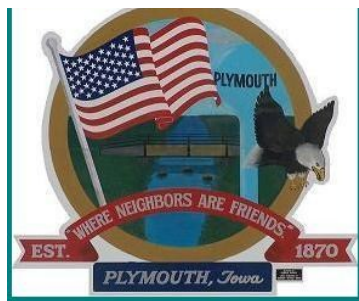

New software for Utilities

As you have all noticed by now, you are receiving a different Utility Bill Postcard generated by our new software. With this new software comes the option to receive **e-bills** and pay from that email. There are fees associated with this. There is a flat \$1.95 if paid with a bank account and a percentage fee if using a card. I believe the percentage fee is less than you are currently being charged by allpaid. Even if you do not use the e-bill feature you are still able to go to: edmundsgovpay.com/PlymouthIA and pay with your account number and PIN that are both located on your bill. Those of you already set up for ACH auto-withdrawal, you have nothing to worry about. It is business as usual with this feature and **NO EXTRA FEE**.

ACH auto payment is still available by signing up at City Hall

Set up an account to save your payment information or use the quick pay feature and enter all your information each month.

Snowmobile Reminders

If you are an owner/operator of a snowmobile there is an Ordinance within City limits to abide by. Snowmobiles shall only be operated on streets that have not been plowed with the exceptions of direct crossings of a prohibited street. Snowmobiles shall not be operated on an operating railroad right-of-way. Snowmobiles are not allowed in any park, playground or upon any other City-owned property without the express permission of the City. Be courteous of public property and do not operate upon the public sidewalks. There is a designated route through town running from the city shop, across B-15, on College to Main. From Main St to Broad and North on Broad out of town. Please stay on this path while traveling through Plymouth. You may get a copy of the designated route at City Hall.

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
