

Plymouth City Council Meeting Proceedings
Thursday, July 2, 2026

The Plymouth Council met in regular session on Thursday July 2nd, at 7:00pm

Mayor Berding called the meeting to order with the following members present – Neal Brennan, Jay Stump, Lissa Merfeld, Zach Ryg and Matt Dirksen.

Others Present: Scott Ryg, Wade Eastman, Karen & Sherri Bolding, Barb Kuhlers and Shane Anderson.

Motion to approve the amended agenda by Ryg, 2nd by Dirksen. Motion carried.

Motion by Brennan, 2nd by Dirksen to accept quote from Quality Pump for the lift station pump. Allowing an additional \$5,000 for expedited installation. Motion carried. Motion by Ryg, 2nd by Brennan to approve quote from Visu Sewer to televise and jet Main St. Alley. Motion carried.

Motion to approve 6/4/2026 minutes by Merfeld, 2nd by Stump. Motion carried.

Motion to approve treasurers report by Brennan, 2nd by Merfeld. Motion carried.

Motion to approve June bills by Merfeld, 2nd by Ryg. Motion carried.

Comments from Council- Dead End Street sign replacement this Fall/Winter, look into Grant for new Street (Name) Signs.

Motion to Adjourn at 7:55pm by Ryg, 2nd by Dirksen. Motion carried.
